# Didik-Kasih EduAid Program

In the second quarter, a total of 30 slots were opened for the first quarter, and 31 students have registered. The class, focusing on 4 core subjects: Bahasa Malaysia, English, Mathematics, and Sciences. These classes filled up a total of 180 student slots for all sessions combined. The attendance rate stands at 75% from the enrolled students.
